Player Guidelines

Practices

- Players must arrive at the field 15-minutes prior to practice time.
- Players must practice in the B' Elite practice uniform (Grey shirt, black shorts, black socks, cold weather Red long sleeve).
- Players must come with a properly inflated soccer ball.
- Players must wear shin-guards.
- Players must bring plenty of water.
- If a player must arrive late or leave a practice early, the coach must be notified in advance.
- If player needs to miss a practice, notification must be made to the COACH.
- Parents are not allowed to step on the field to talk to the coach or the players. In case of emergency, parent must talk to the manager to summon the coach to the sideline.
- If you would like a conference with the coach, an appointment must be made either before or after the practice or at some point during the coach's free time.

Games and Local Tournaments

- Players must arrive at the game field from 30 to 45 minutes before the game.
- Players must arrive properly and uniformly dressed.
- Players must only warm up with their teammates and coaches.
- Players can only be instructed by the coach during the game. The parents' role is strictly encouragement – no coaching.
- Any involvement of the parent with their player during the game has to be designated by the coach (injuries, water breaks etc.)
- If a player will be late for the game or has to leave the game early, the coach must be notified in advance.
- During the games, parents should refrain from making any comments to the game officials. The referees and linesmen should always be dealt with in a professional and courteous manner.
- Parents are not allowed to approach the coach after the game for discussions about playing time, playing position etc. Conferences should be scheduled after 24 hours, No exceptions!
- Every coach, player and parent must behave according to New Jersey league and tournament rules.

Team Selections

- Multiple teams may be offered at each age group depending on the level of interest. With age groups of multiple teams, the players will be assigned based upon skill level.
- Once rosters are set, players cannot be switched from one team to another without express consent of both coaches, the player's parent or guardian and the Director of Coaching.
- Each player, upon accepting an invitation to play on a travel team must complete and provide the following paperwork, which will be provided by the head coach or team manager:
 - Player and Parent Code of Conduct
 - New Jersey Youth Soccer Player Membership Form (if needed)
 - USYS Medical Release Form (notarized if needed)
 - US Club Soccer Player Membership Form
 - Copy of the Player's Birth Certificate
 - 2 x passport-sized photo of the player (head and face)

Team Formation

Player Eligibility

- B' Elite Travel Program follows the guidelines set forth by New Jersey Youth Soccer regarding player eligibility.
- Travel teams for children will be formed for Under 7 (U7) through Under 14 (U14) for fall and spring Seasons. High School teams (U15-U19) will be formed for the spring seasons.
- U8-U14 travel teams may allow younger players that are a maximum of one age group younger than the team's natural age group. U11 teams must be comprised of a majority of actual U11 age players. Players are subject to the selection process as defined in this document.

Selection Process (Tryouts)

- Tryouts will be scheduled by the B' Elite Directors with the approval of the DOC.
- One primary tryout date will be scheduled in mid-April along with a rain date.
- Children qualified to play in age groups from U7 to U14 for the following fall-spring Seasons are eligible to participate in tryouts.
- The Primary Tryout will be evaluated by independent B' Elite evaluators under the supervision of the Director of Coaching. The evaluators will be selected by the Director of Coaching
- During the primary tryout, technical and match condition skills are evaluated. Multiple evaluation criteria are used to score every player's abilities.
- Current team coaches can be present at the tryout.
- Coaches may hold "call back" tryouts within 2 weeks of the primary tryout to evaluate additional players and give players who attended the primary tryout another opportunity to display his/her skills prior to the selection of teams.
- Call backs may be held by individual teams with team coaches evaluating and selecting the players only with the approval of the Director of Coaching and the Selection Committee.
- All interested players are required to tryout and must attend at least one tryout session.
- Players currently on a B' Elite team are not guaranteed a spot on a team for the following season.
- Players may try out for a maximum of two (2) age groups if desired.
- Coaches and the Director of Coaching will select teams within two week of the completion of tryouts.
- Selection Letters must be sent to successful candidates by the coach after the completion of team selections.
- Letters to unsuccessful candidates will be sent by the Coach at the conclusion of team selections.

B' Elite PD Fees

The year round fees for each team are dependent upon the level of activity and roster size. The fees cover the following:

- Professional training costs
- B' Elite PD Club Membership
- Indoor and outdoor facility costs
- Nike uniform (training jacket, home & away uniform, training uniform)
- Director & Club administrative costs
- League, scrimmage and tournament costs (does not include individual travel costs)
- Coach administration & travel costs
